Recycling of Garden Wastes (composts, mulches etc.)	5 points

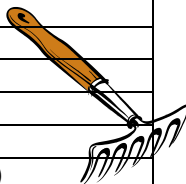

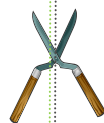
