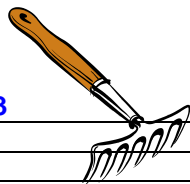


**SCORING GUIDELINES ARE AS FOLLOWS:**



**STANDARDS FOR JUDGING CLASSES 1 TO 3**

General Appeal of garden (colour etc.)	35 points
Condition of plants and maintenance	25 points
Condition of open areas, lawns, paving etc.	8 points
Layout - Placing of trees and shrubs, vistas, skyline, covering unsightly objects, fences etc.	27 points
Recycling of Garden Wastes (composts, mulches etc.)	5 points
Total	100 points
