Classes 1 - 5 Miscellaneous cuts and classes 9-10 Vegetables & Fruit exhibits must be grown by the person/s exhibiting. Classes 6-8 exhibits must be the property of the exhibitor/s for at least 3 months prior to showing (Children 1 month). Decorative 10-12 flowers and foliage may be purchased unless scheduled otherwise. Fresh flowers to be used unless otherwise stated. Embellishments are allowed. Stems to be in water. Children may enter in any section or class.

CLASS MISCELLANEOUS *(to be displayed in supplied vases)*

- 1) 1 vase 3 cuts of Flowering Growth NND NOS.
- 2) 1 vase 3 cuts Foliage NND
- 3) 1 vase 3 cuts, if small, 1 cut if large, bulb, corm or rhizome. NND.
- 4) 1 Camellia, leaving only 2 leaves of foliage,
- 5) 1 vase 3 cuts Flowering Tree, Shrub or Climber. NND NOS

POT PLANTS

- 6) 1 Container of Flowering Plant/s NOS.
- 7) 1 Container of Foliage Plant/s NOS.
- 8) 1 Container Cactus/l and or Succulent/s

VEGETABLES AND FRUIT

- 9) One vegetable
- 10) One fruit unit

DECORATIVE

- 11) "From the Kitchen"
- 12) "In a Basket" Australian Native/Hybrid Arrangement
